ORH administers over 300 contracts designed to expand access to high quality health care for rural and underserved populations.

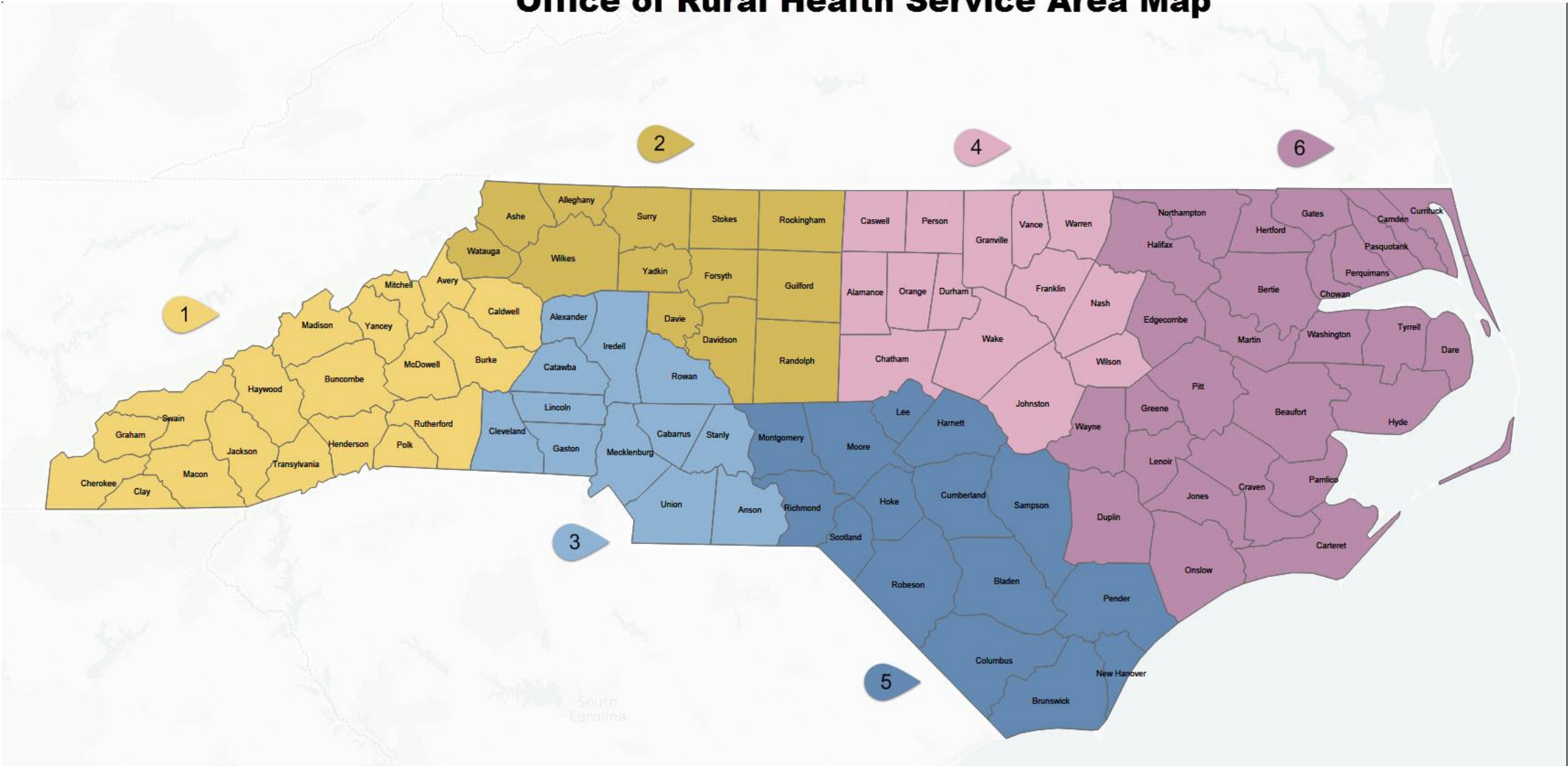
